IN THE BEGINNING



WHAT IS THE COURSE ABOUT?

Some of us may be living life in survival mode with serious doubts about our worth and with real disappointments deep inside. It may be with very little sense of belonging or right to be here. For others, it is a question of sin taking hold. We may have been running on empty for as long as we can remember or have settled for a life of independence and control and becoming a Christian hasn't brought us any real relief.

Over 10 evenings of this course, we will review the primal relationships with our parents: being grateful for all that has been helpful, but also inviting God to show us any areas where we need His grace and healing.

It is through our parents that good foundations were to be laid and it is with our peers that they are tested, so there is a session devoted to them as well.

WHAT HAPPENS AT THE COURSE?

Each evening consists of a time of worship, a teaching from a prepared lesson and then small group time where participants are encouraged to share and to receive prayer ministry. The small groups are all single-sex groups, safe and confidential.

WHO IS IT FOR?

If you identify with any of the following issues, this course is for you: Anxiety, anger, shame, being driven, living behind a mask, issues with authority figures, passivity, emptiness, control, nothing to give, co-dependency, issues with work colleagues, can't say "no", low self esteem, rejection, stuck in unhelpful relationships, loneliness, isolation, rage, self harming etc..

TEACHING AREAS INCLUDE:

- ✠ In the beginning: God & us
- ✠ The Cross
- ✠ God's original intention for our relationship with our mother
- ✠ God's original intention for our relationship with our father
- ✠ Taking our place with our siblings and peers
- ✠ The Healing Process

WHAT WILL IT COST?

There is a fee of £18 per person to cover the cost of the "In the Beginning" manual and materials. We need to receive payment before the course commences. Please make cheques payable to Yeovil Vineyard Church.
